

# what's your fancy?

**If you are interested in Topical Fish, read on ...**

*Fighting super ffurneaux* – A pale almost spherical fish. When excited the head is suffused with most glorious shades of red and purple.

*Chubby Challis or Boyo fish* – Similar to the above but with a black patch on top of the head. We are finding it difficult to breed but have hopes.

*Nightshift Byttcher or Plotter erroneous kritikos* – Needs careful handling and cannot survive singly or even in pairs, but a shoal will cause quite a stir. Spawning tanks will soon be set up and supplies plentiful. Incompatible with Top-Dogfish.

*Compilation Blundder* – Virtually unknown until quite recently but some fine specimens can be seen from time to time.

*Repro Chukklers* – Amusing fish which tend to impede the progress of others. Cause considerable tank pollution.

*Minor Execs* – Keep singly in small dark tanks. In pairs they fight to the death. They become very aggressive when a mirror is held to the glass.

*St.Leger-fish* - Builds a nest in a dark corner and vigorously defends it against intruders.

*Celtic Bossfish or Whyntyng-Whopper* – Thrives on a daily dose of 'Pinkney's gripes'.

*Yarpie Mudflinger or Mudcripper* – An African fish of great size which stirs up the sediment.

*Top Dogfish* – Remains immobile and in seclusion for long periods but attacks the other fish without provocation twice each year.

*Lord's Molly or Ribdigging de Vin* – Spends 3 days at one end of the tank and 2 days at the other end.

*Cartographic Drafter* – Difficult to keep but the fry are plentiful and cheap.

These and other queer fish are obtainable from Noel Gray (fishmonger) in Kelsh section; and all are on display in this building.
